

### Why Build & Repair Cams? CAMDRIVE Benefits:

- · All units come equipped with a mechanical die spring return . . . a READY SuperSpring®

### How to Select the Right Unit:

- 1. Choose the model number from page 3 which covers the required point diameter (D) and stroke (A).
- 2. Confirm that the model's tonnage exceeds the total force (piercing + stripping) required. Total Force = (hole perimeter x material thickness x material tensile strength) + stripping force from page 3 table.
- 3. Select options on pages 4 and 5. PLEASE NOTE: point size on standard punches must be specified.

#### CAMDRIVE Do's & Don'ts

DO: key in back of unit to resist force.

DO: effect piercing in last quarter of max stroke A.


DO: remember punch stroke equals press stroke (1:1 ratio).

DON'T: mount CAMDRIVE® greater than ±15° without using angle mount option trigger. Note: ±30° max angle with option. No positive return on angle mounts.

DON'T: overstroke the unit. Max trigger stroke = 90% of A


## The CAMDRIVE® Rappel


The rappel is an internal component that differs with each available option. A rappel can always be changed to a different configuration later providing maximum user flexibility. Standard






## CAMDRIVE® - The Compact Cam with "Interchangeable Precision"





(with fully closed stroke)





#### STANDARD PUNCH OPTIONS:


- READY offers CAMDRIVE® punches in two point configurations; custom round pointed (please specify "D" dimension at time of order) and in a punch blank configuration (customer to grind point).
- Piercing must take place during the last 25% of stroke.
  Allow additional stroke for punch re-sharpening, when applicable. Do not exceed 90% of stroke.
- READY recommends sharpening a punch no more than two times during the course of its life.
- Special ejector style punches also available upon request.






